Situated on the north side of West Church Street facing south is a two story, three bay brick house. It has a standing seam tin roof, louvered shutters, two over two double hung sash and a common bond brick front on a limestone foundation. The main entrance is in the eastern bay of the south facade. The building was constructed in the latter part of the 19th century.


