DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the west side of North Vermont Street. It is a one and a half story five bay brick structure built in two parts. A frame shed dormer extending almost the entire length of the house has been added. The two north bays appear to be older. Bricks are laid in Flemish bond with a water table. The window has a six over nine light sash within a wide frame with ovolo molding. The door in the north bay is newer but retains original framing. It includes a transom. The three south bays may be later. There is no water table. Windows have nine over six light sashes. An entrance is located in the third bay from the south end. A shed roofed porch extends across the entire front elevation. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.


