This house, dating from the late 19th or early 20th century is located on the south side of West Salisbury Street. It is a two story, three bay frame structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two pane sashes. The main entrance is located in the center bay and includes a transom. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. Corbeled brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.
