DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the south side of East Church Street and is a three story, five bay brick building, painted white. The end walls terminate with parapets at the gables. At the front elevation, windows have six over six pane double hung sashes topped with wide wood lintels with decorated corner blocks. The ground level story has had its fenestration altered. The main entrance is located at the second story level in the center bay. Surrounding the door is a broad transom and sidelights. Double inside end chimneys are located at the gables. Windows in the end walls have segmental arches above them suggesting a late 19th century alteration. The house would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century.
