DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located on the east side of South Artizan Street is a one story brick house which probably dates from the late 18th century. The walls are laid in Flemish bond at the front elevation and there is a molded brick water table extending across the wall. Windows have moderately wide frames with modern single pane sashes. The entrance is off center, located in the north central bay. A modern, two bay cast iron porch has been added. Also, a hip roofed dormer was added to the west slope of the roof. Brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.
