DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the southeast corner of Artizan and Church Streets, is a one and a half story structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. It is probably of log construction. Main story windows have single pane sashes. Smaller three over three light sashes light the upper story. There is no window at the upper story in the center bay. The entrance is centrally located. There is also a small central brick flue. A one story shed extension is attached to the south end wall. The house would appear to date from the second half of the 19th century.
