This double house is located on the east side of the first block of South Artizan Street. It is a two story, four bay frame structure covered with German siding. Windows have single pane double hung sashes trimmed with flat topped molded architraves. There are only two windows at the second story front, located in the outer bays. Two entrances are side by side in the center bays. The house would appear to date from the early 20th century.
