Situated on the east side of North Artizan Street facing west is a two story, three bay, frame house of the first quarter of the 20th century. The hip roof is covered with slate and there is a hip roofed dormer in the front. A large wrap around porch on the south west and north sides is one story high and has a pedimented gable at the main entrance. The house is covered with composition siding.
