This house located on the west side of North Artizan Street is a two story, four bay frame structure. The most notable architectural feature is the semi-hexagonal projecting window bay terminating with a tower having a polyagonal pointed top. Windows have single pane double hung sashes. The main entrance is located in the second bay from the south end. The house would appear to date from about 1900 and is in good condition.
