DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the west side of North Artizan Street is a two story, three bay frame structure dating from the late 19th century. It is covered with German siding and features a central cross gable with a round arched window. Other windows have six over six pane sashes and are trimmed with pedimented architraves. The main entrance is located in the north end bay of the front elevation and includes a transom. There is a small shed extension to the rear. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal.

The house is in good condition.


