Located on the west side of South Artizan Street and built against WA-WIL-292 is this one and a half story, four bay log house sheathed with board and batten siding. Its windows have two over two pane sashes except for those at the upper level. There are two entrances in the center bays. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. The house is in fair condition and would appear to date from the mid to late 19th century.
