This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a two story, three bay frame structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. It probably dates from the early 20th century. Windows have two over two pane sashes. The main entrance is in the central bay, off-set to the south. There is no transom. An exterior block flue rises against the north end wall. The house appears to be in good condition.
