DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the east side of South Vermont Street is a two story, four bay frame duplex covered with German siding. It probably dates from the early 20th century. Windows have two over two pane double hung sashes. Two entrances are located side by side in the center bays. One door, toward the south, has a transom. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. A brick chimney extends from inside the north end wall. A cursory examination would suggest that fenestration at the front wall has been altered. The house is in good condition.
