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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, a small two and one half story, two bay Italianate structure is located on the east side of South Vermont Street, part of a trio of buildings with flat roofed Italianate blocks at either end. This frame structure is sheathed with German siding. It has flat pilasters at either end of the front elevation. Capping the pilasters are massive scrolled brackets beneath an overhanging roof. Windows have six over six pane sashes. The first story windows have been replaced with a modern bay window. The main entrance is located in the north bay of the front elevation. In addition to the brackets, the eaves are finished with dentils and the frieze has decorative ventilators. The porch across the front of the building is modern. The house appears to be in excellent condition and dates from the late 19th century.
