 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, on the east side of South Vermont Street is a one and a half story, three bay log dwelling resting on moderately high field-stone foundations. The house is covered with lapped wood siding. Windows have two over two pane sashes and there is a modern shed roofed dormer extending from the roof. The main entrance is in the north end bay of the front elevation. The roof is covered with standing seam sheet metal. An exterior block flue rises along the north end wall. The house appears to be in good condition and probably dates from the early 19th century.
