 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located in a triangular area between South Vermont Street and Commerce Street. It faces east onto Vermont Street. It is a one and a half story, three bay frame structure with concrete sheathed foundations. The walls are covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two or single pane sashes. There are two gable roofed wall dormers. There is a central chimney as well as a modern block exterior flue. A two story ell extends to the rear. The main entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation. The house is in good condition and probably dates from the early 20th century.
