DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house, located on the east side of North Vermont Street is a two story, three bay frame structure dating from about 1900. Its walls are covered with composition siding. Windows have single pane double hung sashes which are probably original, trimmed with plain flat topped architraves. The main entrance is located in the central bay. It does not include a transom. There is a small central brick flue and a sheet metal roof which overhangs the walls. The house appears to be in good condition.


