




DESCRIPTION

Contributing Resource Count: 1

Despite its modern appearance, Naval Academy North Severn documents indicate construction of Building NA38 (Boat Shed/AOIC Garage) originally occurred in 1928. Located at the north end of Hooper High Road adjacent to a boat ramp and dock protruding into Mill Creek near Possum Point in Anne Arundel County, Maryland, Building NA38 stands one story tall with gable roofs covering its single vehicle garage and its four-bent wide attached boat shed (Photo 41500-2). A poured-concrete bulkhead wall parallels the east elevation of Building NA38. Immediately west of the structure, blacktop composing Hooper High Road's road surface leads northward to the boat ramp and dock.

Asphalt shingles sheathe the shed/garage's gable roofs while vertical plywood panels provide exterior covering on the garage. A concrete block foundation set atop a poured-concrete pad supports the garage's internal framing. The concrete pad continues northward and forms the base upon which square wooden posts forming the boat shed's bents rest. Upbraces help carry the load of the boat shed's wooden-truss roof framing. A pair of wooden double-leaf doors provide access from the open shed into the garage. An aluminum, vertically-rolling garage door penetrates the garage's west elevation. Horizontally-sliding sash windows occupy the garage's south gable end (Photo 41500-3).
