Building NA73, located in the North Severn area of the US Naval Academy in Anne Arundel County, is not located within the boundaries of a National Register-eligible historic district, nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

Building NA 101 was built in 1918 as Quarters C, a single-family residence. It is a 1-1/2-story bungalow-type dwelling of frame construction and covered with a hipped roof. The walls are clad with vinyl siding and has replacement windows. The building lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify for listing on the Register under Criterion C. The building served a secondary role to the primary mission of the Naval Radio Transmitter Facility (North Severn) and is thus not eligible under Criterion A.





Known as Quarters C and erected in 1918 according to Naval Academy North Severn records, Building NA101 stands on the northeast corner of Hooper High Road's intersection with Beach Circle Drive near Possum Point in Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Although primarily surrounded by grass lawns, a mature tree and large shrub shield much of the dwelling's main elevation facing Hooper High Road (Photo 41500-5). The building rises one-and-one-half stories tall topped by an asphalt-shingled hipped roof. The Quarters also possess small shed-roof dormers on three of its roof slopes and a square brick chimney pile penetrating its northern slope (Photo 41500-4). An enclosed, shed-roofed vestibule protects the west entrance. Stucco covers the building's foundation while vinyl siding sheathes the exterior wall surfaces. A bulkhead entrance pierces the north foundation.

The main, hipped-roof section of the dwelling consists of a rectangular plan three bays wide along its west elevation and four bays deep on its north elevation. Most window openings contain eight-over-eight aluminum sash. The dormers contain louvered ventilators. The dwelling's formal entry, composed of a four-panel door with six lights, occupies the center of the west porch's seven bays. Pairs of eight-over-eight and single six-over-six sash flank the central door. A modern wooden porch leads to the door.
