The foundation and floor of the structure are concrete, and the walls are exposed concrete block. The structure is covered with a hip roof of asphalt shingles. There is a small ventilating monitor located at the center of the roof. The structure originally had one window on one side, now blocked up, and has two doors opposite each other on the ends.

Building #04718 is one of the earlier buildings constructed in the development of the base. Its primary purpose was to serve the east, administrative portion of the base. It continues to serve that function. Built in 1943 the building is effectively unchanged. The current roof is new, and one original window has been covered.
