They burned the buildings and ware houses of St. Leonard's Town, and confiscated the tobacco stored there. This town, established by an Act of the General Assembly in 1735, was never rebuilt and remains as an archaeological site.



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
CHESAPEAKE BAY

 SCALE 1"=300'


BASE MAP CONSTRUCTED FROM THE GROUND PLAT MAP 171/365 TO 171/365
