Although this house is no longer on the same property as the Leonard Long house, it was at one time a tenant house for that farm. Access was not gained to the interior and modern siding resulted in only a superficial examination of the exterior. It appears to be a genuine 1½ story frame house not totally unlike William Hodges house (CLVT-120), it is curious to note that both William Hodges and Leonard Long were watermen.
