STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This is one of several cross-gable houses along Sixes Road, each of which plays a part in creating the nineteenth century flavor that prevails in this neighborhood.

The center hall plan provided for two rooms downstairs and two above. The single story semi-detached kitchen had been removed and is being used for a shed on the same property. It has been placed south of the house next to a contemporary cornhouse.
