## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Stanley Bowen lives in a house that his parents obtained c. 1917. It is a simple wood frame-and-clapboard building which has a side hall, two rooms downstairs and two above. The single story kitchen has been removed from the back or north facade. The 2/2 windows and deep cornices are typical Victorian features found in houses in this county which were built during the first decade of the twentieth century and the last of the nineteenth century.
