Late 19th Century

This L-shaped two-story frame farmhouse comprises one northern and one eastern leg. The eastern section measures three bays across its eastern gable end, by two bays long. The northern section, facing the Patuxent River to the west, stands five bays long by one deep. A brick stove flue heats the north gable end.

The house is covered with asbestos shingles and stands on a concrete-covered foundation. Louvered shutters flank the modern 1/1 sash.

Several frame sheds complete the farmstead.


