Late 19th Century

This nicely finished two-story frame farmhouse measures five bays long by two deep. A central cross-gable and bracketed porch distinguish the south-facing facade. A kitchen section extends to the rear.

In the central bay, a door appears on the first floor, a short square window lights the second floor, and another square window lights the cross-gable. Stove flues in the center of the building heat the rooms on either side of a central stair hall.

Four frame tobacco barns surround the house.


