DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Early 20th Century

The main block of this three-part frame farmhouse stands two stories tall. It measures one bay in depth by three bays across the south facade. The middle section, running perpendicular to the main block, rises two stories in height and is two bays long. The last part to the north is a two-bay-long one-story kitchen.

Stove flues heat the north gable end of the kitchen and the junction of the other two sections. The main block's facade includes a western door sheltered by a pedimented porch. 6/6 sash windows light the house. Louvered shutters flank the windows on the facade.

A screened porch covers the west side of the middle section.

Two frame sheds stand to the north.


UNKIRK 2 MI
