This house is a two story, three bay frame structure which faces east. It is sheathed with lapped wooden siding and has six over six pane window sashes with simple architraves. The main entrance is located in the north end bay of the front elevation. A pair of sidelights flank the door. There is a modern gable roofed front porch.

The roof is sheathed with sheet metal. One of the most notable features of the exterior is the pair of brick chimneys located against the south gable wall.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Although it has been much altered, this house may have originated as a side-hall double-parlor dwelling heated by double end chimneys. This type was popular in Calvert County from 1790 to 1860. This house may have appeared similar to CT-19, His Lordship's Favor, a well-preserved 1839 house of this style.


