DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, four bay frame structure covered with asbestos shingle siding. It consists of a three bay section with a central cross gable and a one bay forward projecting gable at the south end of the west or front elevation. The two front facing gables are trimmed with decorated shingles. Windows have two over two pane sashes which have no decorative trim. In each of the two front gables are arched topped windows with four lights. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends. The main entrance is located in the third bay from the north end of the front wall. It is surrounded by a transom and sidelights. Across the three recessed bays of the front wall is a hipped roofed porch supported by turned posts.





