Late 19th century

This two-story frame house measures five-bays wide by one-bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section. 2/2 sash windows light the dwelling. The front corners of the south elevation are beveled forming semi-hexagonal corner bays. The structure is covered with asbestos shingle siding with decorative shingles in the gables and at the beveled corners. The main entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures five bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section.

The front corners of the south elevation are beveled, forming semi-hexagonal corner bays. Windows in these corner bays are set on a diagonal to the plane of the front and side walls. The structure is covered with asbestos shingle siding. At the gables and in the beveled corners are a combination of decorative scalloped and diamond shaped shingles.

The main entrance is located in the central bay of the front elevation and includes a transom and sidelights around the door. A hipped roof porch supported by turned posts extends across the five bays of the front elevation. A brick chimney is located at the interior of the house, east of the cross gable. Another chimney is located in the rear ell.






