DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This plain frame house measures three bays long by one bay deep. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a kitchen section. The dwelling stands two stories tall.

The entire structure is covered with aluminum siding. Windows have 6/6 sashes and they are not aligned with one another at the first and second stories at the front elevation. The main entrance is located in the center bay and includes a narrow transom and sidelights surrounding the door. The most noticeable feature of the house is the large modern two story pedimented front porch. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable end walls. There is a one story semi-attached out kitchen.




