This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen. 2/2 sash windows light the dwelling.

The structure is covered with composition siding. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front or south elevation. It includes a narrow transom and sidelights around the door. Across the front is a hipped roof porch with a central cross gable beneath the main cross gable. The porch is supported by turned posts with simple brackets. Brick chimneys are located inside the gable ends.


