DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. A prominent cross-gable distinguishes the facade. The gable-roofed house includes a front porch and a rear kitchen section. Six over six sash windows light the dwelling.

Turned porch posts and six over six windows are the only architecturally interesting extant elements. The west facade's northernmost bay contains the entrance. Interior brick stove-flue chimneys heat the center of the main block and the east end of the two-story ell. Exterior finishes consist of patterned metal sheets on the roof, aluminum siding on the walls, and concrete on the foundation.

Two 20th-century gambrel-roofed barns and several other frame farm buildings complete the complex.




