DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This one-story frame dwelling appears to have been built in three stages. The six-bay, by one-bay building is covered by a gable roof running east-west. Six over six windows light the house.

An interior brick chimney appears between the second and third bays from the west. An exterior brick chimney heats the east end.

On the south side, a shed-roofed sheet metal addition covers the two center bays, one of which contains the entrance. The 16'6" deep, building's three sections measure, from east to west, 16', 16' and 14', respectively.

The house rests on brick piers. Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof. Regular, lapped weatherboards sheath the building.




