Plain lapped weatherboards cover this simple two-story frame dwelling. The small house measures two bays wide by one bay deep. A gable roof covers the house. A one-story kitchen section add space to the house.

A two-bay-square, shed-roofed, one-story section fills the northeast corner. Entrances appear in the main section's eastern bay on the north facade and in the northern bay of the two-bay kitchen's east side. Six over six sash windows light the house. A brick chimney heats the exposed end of each of the three sections.


