According to information prepared by SHA, the Ozella Mackall House, located at 1100 M.F. Bowen Road, Prince Frederick vicinity, does not meet any of the National Register Criteria for listing. The simple frame I-house with rear ell and cross gable was probably constructed in the early years of the 20th century and does not appear to embody distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction or possess high artistic value. It is not located in any known historic district.

A central unfenestrated cross-gable highlights this two-story cross-gable farmhouse. The typical three-bay by one-bay frame building comprises a southern stove flue and a northern entrance. A one-story hip-roofed porch covers the east facade. A kitchen section runs to the west. The roof retains pressed-tin beavertail roofing. A garage is located south of the house, while a small barn stands to the southwest.




