Scalloped shingles decorate the gables and cross-gable of this two-story frame farmhouse. A bracketed porch featuring turned posts shelters the south and east sides. The four-bay by two-bay dwelling displays unusual door placement. On the south facade a simple door appears in the second bay from the left. On the east gable end, a more elaborate entrance comprising sidelights and a transom occupies the right-hand bay. Plain flat boards frame the 2/2 sash windows. An arched window lights the southern cross-gable.

A stove flue heats the west end. A kitchen addition stands to the rear. German siding covers the building.


