This typical three-bay by two-bay two-story frame farmhouse includes an unfenestrated central cross-gable and a two story kitchen addition to the east. The kitchen's east gable end is heated by a stove flue. This section's north side is lighted by a single window in the first floor, and two in the second floor.

The main house is heated by a northern stove flue. A screened porch covers the west facade. Regular narrow weatherboards sheath the building. Plain boards frame the 2/2 and 6/6 sash windows.


