The front part of the house is probably the oldest section. It is a simple vernacular building with a central entrance. Windows have two pane sashes. The roof is sheathed with sheet metal and a brick chimney with a corbeled top extends from inside the north end wall. There is also a brick chimney in the rear wing.




