This house is a two story, five bay frame structure with a central cross-gable. It has a modern two story addition and a garage attached to its east end. Windows have two over two pane sashes. A hip roofed porch extends across the front elevation. It is supported by turned posts with decorative scroll cut brackets. Interior brick chimneys project from the roof ridge approximately opposite the base of each side of the cross-gable.


