DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story frame house commands a fine view of the Patuxent River to the west. A Palladian window lighting the west gable end's attic, and a southern polygonal turret capped by a tent roof lend distinction to the house.

The building measures three bays across the gable end. A central entrance faces the river. The south side comprises one bay to the west and the turret to the east. 1/1 windows light the house.

A porch featuring turned posts crosses the west end and south side, to the turret. Two brick chimneys protrude from the roof's center. Modern asphalt shingles cover the roof. Asbestos blocks sheath the walls.


