This one-story log cottage faces east. A screened porch covers this side. The gabled building is heated by a northern chimney constructed of local composite stone. The chimney is built of brick above its shoulders.

A small window lights either gable end of the deteriorating cottage. The small logs forming the cottage walls are square-notched and nailed together with wire nails. Plain lapped siding sheathes the gable ends.




