DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house comprises four sections. From north to south, the first three parts are covered by roofs with north-south roof lines. The two-story, gabled southernmost section stands perpendicular to the previous three.

The northernmost section, a one story, two bay building, is heated at the north gable end by an exterior brick stove flue chimney. The next section, a two story two bay part, is heated by a similar chimney at its south gable end. The third part is a one-bay section whose gambrel roof is lit by a gabled dormer. The perpendicular section measures three bays wide across its gable end. A brick chimney heats its east end.

Six over six windows light the house. A wheel window lights the west gable of the last section. Modern composition shingles cover the roof.

A frame tobacco barn stands to the north.




