This house faces south onto Hunting Creek Road (Hwy. 521). It is an example of the 1920's continuation of the Colonial Revival, a story-and-a-half framed and weatherboarded, gambrel-roofed structure. There are two exterior end-wall chimneys partially concealed by one-story wings that are original to the house. A shed-roofed monitor dormer lights the second story. The facade is three bays long, but both of the bays that flank the side-lighted and transomed central doorway are made up of clusters of windows. The original sash are six over one. A porch shelters the first story of the facade. It has a pedimented roof and classical moldings.




