This mid-twentieth-century bungalow faces north onto D Street. Set on a low concrete-block foundation, it is a framed structure covered with asbestos shingles. The structure has a gable roof and is two rooms deep. The three-bay facade is composed of a central doorway and flanking pairs of windows with six-over-one double-hung sash. The front doorway is sheltered by a segmental-arched and gable-roofed stoop. An upper story is illuminated only by pairs of windows set into the gable-end wall.


