This farmstead includes a small one story, four bay frame house with two front entrances. Windows are located in the first and third bays from the west end and have 6/6 sash. There is a full size window in the west gable. Entrances are located to the east of each of the windows. Each door is hung beneath a transom. Both doors have lintel levels higher than those of the windows. A central brick chimney extends from the roof peak. The roof is covered with sheet metal.

A frame tobacco barn is located south of the house.



