DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Marshalland is a two part small frame dwelling built in the early 19th century and enlarged later in the century.

Its early part resembles the early portion of Hole-in-the-Wall closeby, with a side entrance and two windows on the first story and two dormers on the second story. Adjacent its entrance side was added a single bay two story wing. Both sections are built upon low brick foundations and are covered with asbestos siding. Behind the old sections is a leanto addition which creates, probably, four rooms on the first story.

On its east end is an outside chimney and on the west a small flue within the gable.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Marshland is important to the survey of historic and early buildings as a representative example of early 19th century vernacular architecture, which has been changed little since it was constructed and subsequently enlarged. As a typical vernacular house it represents the vast section of early Marylanders who lived in such buildings.
