About 1860 a congregation on the St. Mary's Circuit of the Methodist Episcopal Church was formed by James Joy and Miley Jones. In 1868 Joy deeded the present site to the Church for the erection of a small chapel. This building stood until 1895 when it was replaced by a second one which burned in 1931. In 1968 a modern brick chapel was constructed on the site of the first two buildings.

This site serves as the cemetery of Hollywood United Methodist Church. The oldest gravestone, dating from 1865, is that of a Union soldier from Hollywood, one of the few in this predominantly pro-Confederate area. This stone pre-dates the first Joy Chapel by three years and may indicate an earlier use of the property by local Methodists.
