Dr. Thomas Gerrard, a member of the Maryland Council, occupied a house on Pork Hall when he attended the Assembly sessions at St. Mary's City. Gerrard died in 1673.

The cellar of a brick house owned by a Mr. Cherry on the 1798 Federal Direct Tax survives under the present frame structure at this site. The remains show a plan of three rooms with chimneys at one end.
