This house began as a one room, side passage frame building covered with riven oak clapboards which survive on the south gable. Soon after this initial construction, the house was lengthened to include a small room on the other side of the passage. The enlarged house was then reclad with beaded weatherboards. The tilted false plates are boxed and beaded. The exterior chimneys at each end have been replaced with stove flues.
